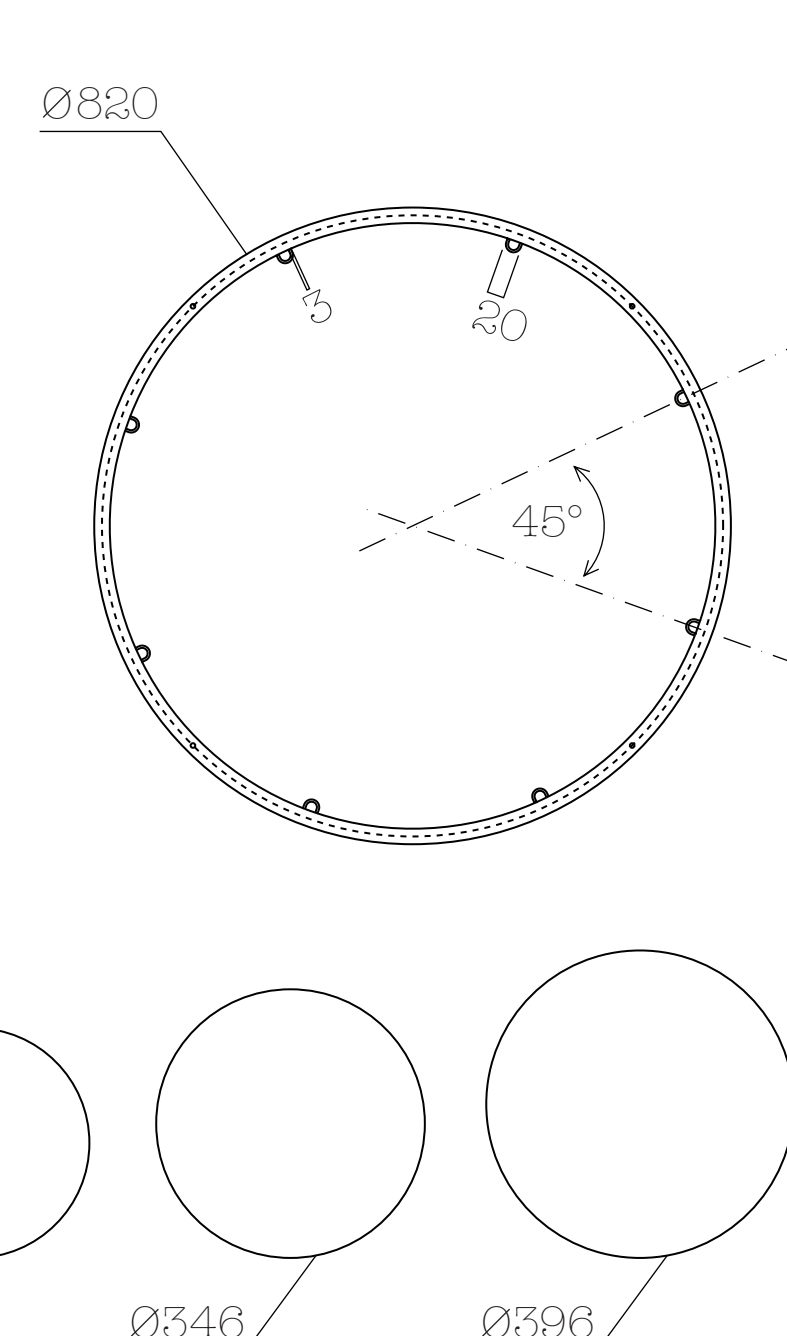
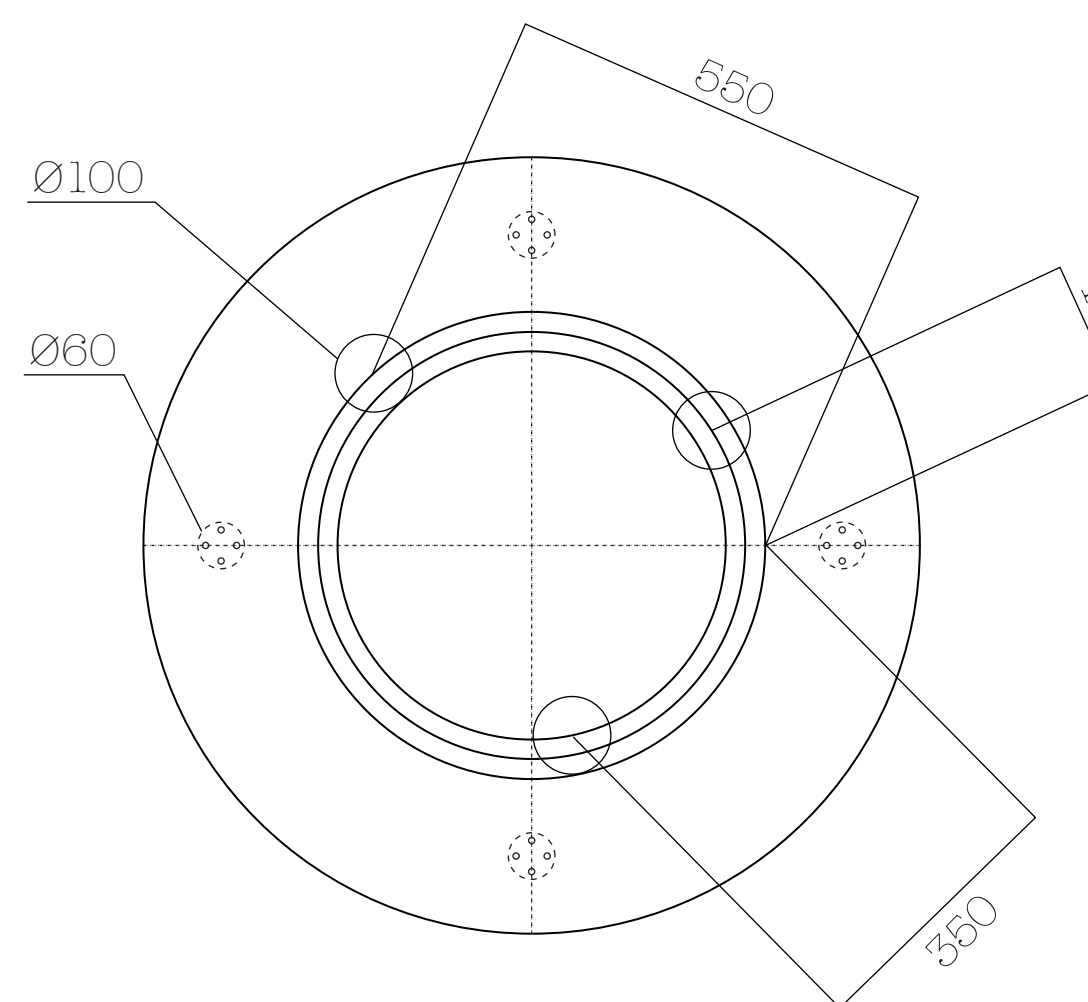
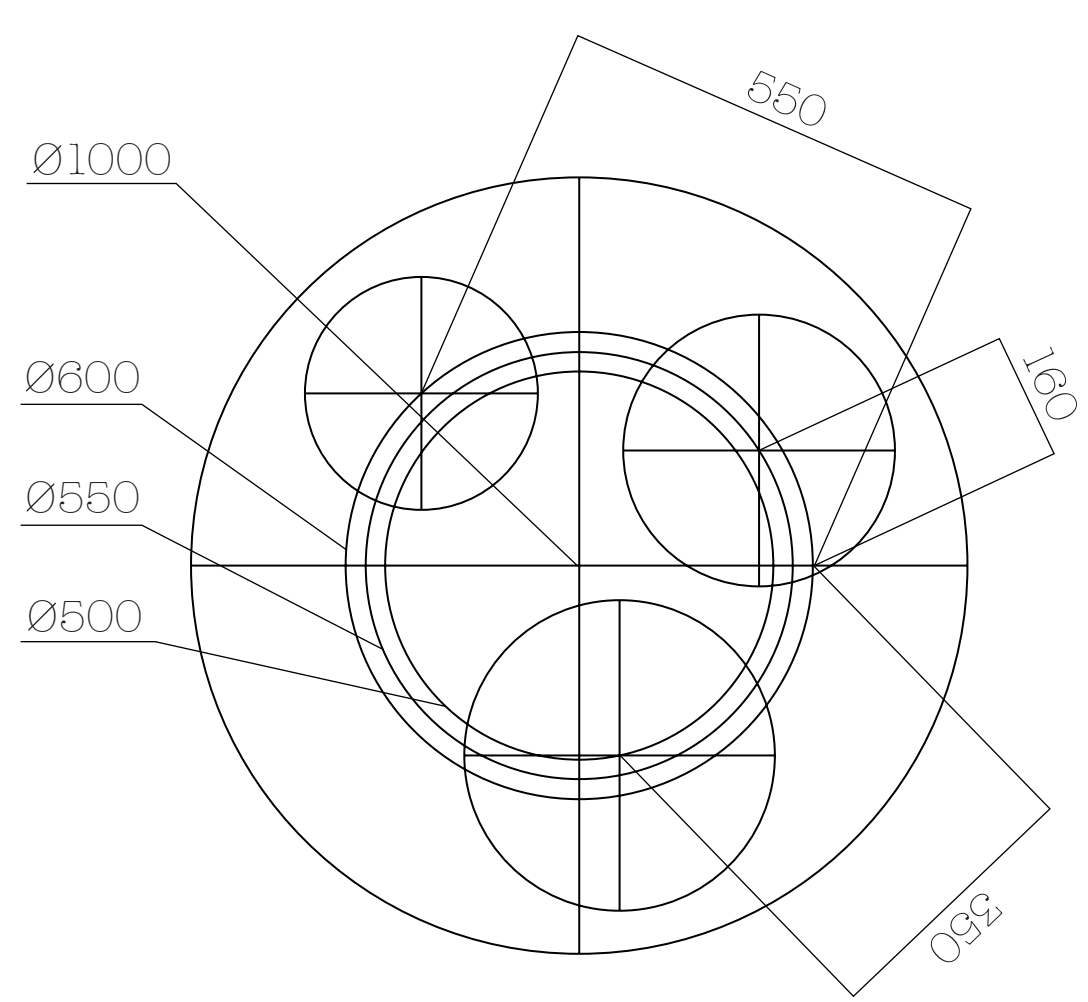
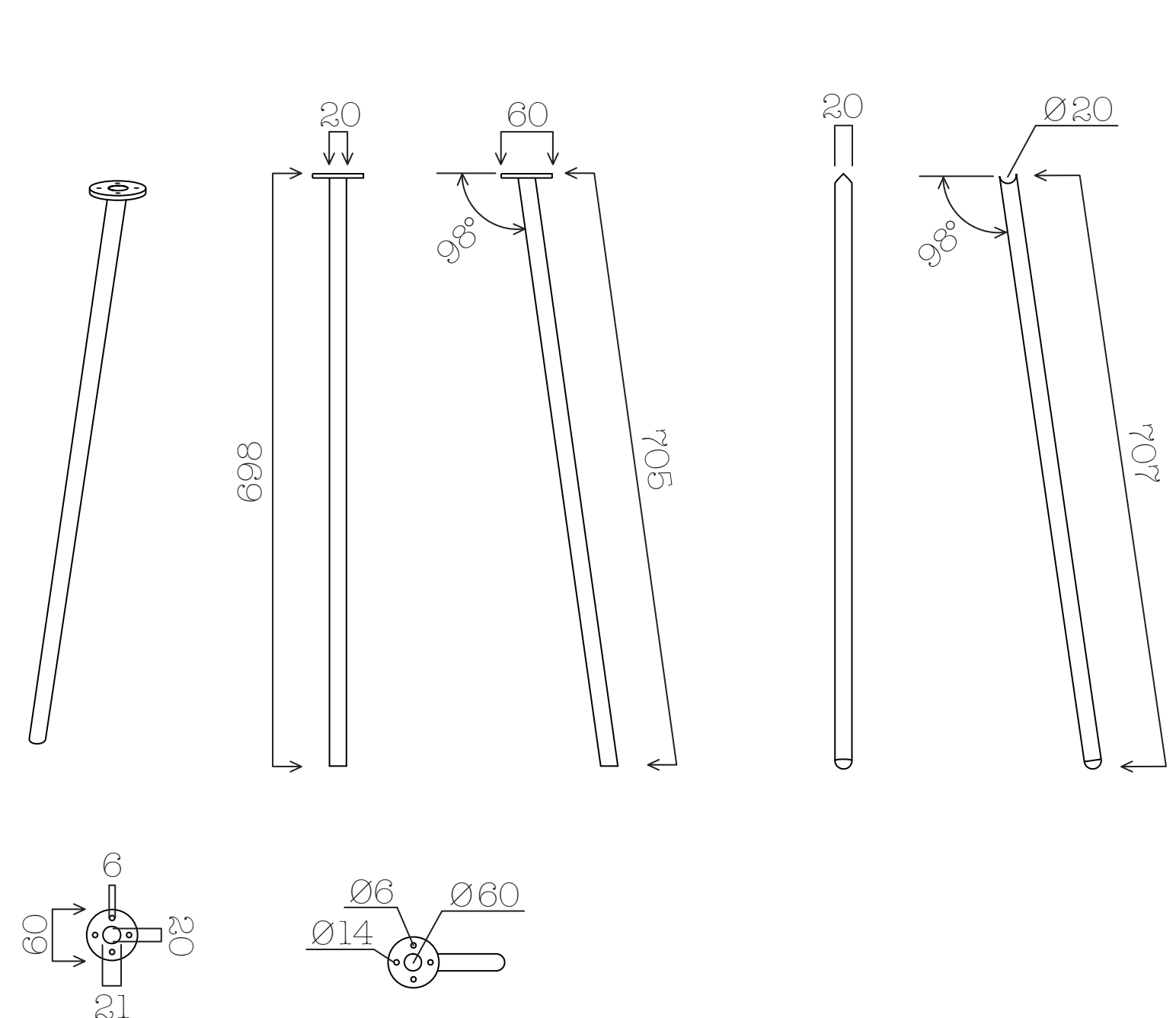


TABLE PLAN 1:1



A. Circles—marqueteries are shaped from plywood with a surface finish selected by us /laminated plastic, veneer/ /it is important to grind down the plywood to remove the thickness of surface material/

B. C. Circles are cut out roughly from plywood, openings for marqueteries are made in them, boards are agglutinated together and provided with a surface finish /laminated plastic, veneer/. Final openings and recessing for legs are shaped /variant d2/, openings for M6 inserts are predrilled.

D. 1-Fixtures for the net and legs are welded on a tube, footboard is connected with a board with screws M6x20.

D. 2-Legs are welded / soldered on a part cut out with laser / water jet / a saw. The legs are finished with a file and end covers. The legs are screwed to the board with countersunk screws M6x20.
